



24H URINES

MIMPORTANT

IF YOU HAVE DIFFERENT TYPES OF SAMPLE TO TAKE, THE BLOOD SAMPLE SHOULD ALWAYS BE TAKEN LAST.

EQUIPMENT

To take this sample, we provide you with:

• 1 x 2-litre red-capped container for collection

• 60 ml red-capped jar for the sample to be sent

▲ IMPORTANT

- Write down the total volume of urine collected in the cup over the 24 hours on the label of the bag provided for this purpose.
- If the volume of urine exceeds 2 litres, please <u>use a clean</u> <u>personal container</u> of greater volume to collect all the urine.
- If you forget to collect your urine once during the collection period, you must start the whole operation again from the beginning.

BEFORE TAKING YOUR SAMPLE: Please ask your doctor to find out whether your current treatment (medication, dietary supplement, etc.) should be temporarily suspended.

STEP 1



Wash your hands thoroughly.

STEP 2

Urinate in the toilet first thing in the morning (e.g. at 8:00 am), then start collecting your urine for 24 hours (including the next day's urine at 8:00 am) in the cup. Store the urine in the refrigerator for the duration of the collection.

STEP 3



Mix all the urine collected in the cup.

STEP 4



Pour a sample of the urine collected into the small jar supplied in the kit. Fill in the jar as <u>full as possible</u>.

STEP 5



On the label on the jar, write your full name and date of birth, as well as <u>the total volume</u> <u>of urine collected</u> in the jar over the course of 24 hours.

Then place the jar in the special "Emballinfor" bag.
